UPON BOOKING CONFIRMATION

Include dates of Life Education Queensland's visit in your parent newsletter and remember to include a link to the Life Education Hub where parents can <u>login</u> and get more information about the program.

TERM PRIOR TO VISIT

Organise permission forms and payment requirements for parents. <u>Here's an example.</u>

Send a copy of last year's Life Education Queensland booking timetable to teachers to assist with module selection.

Coordinate with staff to finalise visit timetable and complete and return the Class Needs Analysis to your educator.

Promote visit details through your parent newsletter. Remember to share it via your social media page and tag @LifeEducationQueensland. <u>Here are some assets to</u> <u>help.</u>

Communicate visit dates and van requirements with your groundsman, janitor or other responsible person to minimise disruptions. <u>Here are some important things to</u> <u>remember.</u>
